Improve reading results with:


- 100% of students to achieve 12 months growth in 12 months in reading
- 100% of identified students to reach PM benchmark at the end of 2017
- 100% of identified students already at PM benchmark to exceed end of year benchmark
- 100% of students to demonstrate typical improvement in PAT M test.

Our initiatives include

- Funding a cluster Data Analyst to support band 5 schools in collating and analysing reading and numeracy data across small schools, with the aim being to identify common trends and inform our shared practice for school improvement using the inquiry cycle.
- Providing professional development in reading to develop teachers' knowledge and skills needed to plan for and deliver effective teaching to enhance reading outcomes for all students.
- Developing teacher capability in the implementation of a whole school reading framework.
- Funding a Speech Language Service in collaboration with Wallumbilla State School with the aim to being to support our Early Years to assess and deliver programs to develop pre reading skills, in particular oral language.

Employing a data analyst with the cluster 2 days per semester	\$2000
Engaging in professional development through webinars and face to face in how to teach reading.	\$3000
Providing TRS to enable staff to collaborate and implement reading framework.	\$3000
